Course format will be lecture, class discussions based on assigned readings from assigned texts, as well as supplemental sources, reports, videos, and field trips.

Prerequisite(s): HIST 001 United States History to 1877 or HIST 002 United States Society and Culture since 1877, or permission of the instructor.
