FRNCH 206 French Literature of the Nineteenth Century

3 hours

French 206 is an advanced French course with an emphasis on short fiction and poetry of the nineteenth century. The course serves to introduce students to the principal writers and literary movements of the nineteenth century from Romanticism to Symbolism. Students will develop literary analysis skills while improving their written and oral French skills. (Not open to native speakers of French.) Prerequisite(s): French 102 or permission of the department.
