Students who want to pursue a B.F.A degree will need to go through a B.F.A. Clearance. In order to qualify, students must complete or be currently enrolled in required art core courses ([ART 1050 Art Research](#), [ART 1300 Introduction to Drawing](#), and [ART 2300 Intermediate Drawing](#)) as well as one introductory art history course, and introductory (1000-level) courses in both 2-D and 3-D media. The applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.00 in all art classes completed within the Art Department at the time of the review. The B.F.A. Clearance will be held concurrently with the annual portfolio review that is required for art majors. The art department faculty will evaluate the portfolio and inform the student of its decision to allow for time to plan schedules.
