SOCWK 5270 Generalist Field Practicum

Social Work (Graduate)

This course provides students with supervised learning experiences in selected social work agencies. The experience introduces a variety of social work practice roles and enables the student to apply social work knowledge, skills, and values in a real practice situation. The MSW Program requires students to complete 8 credit hours of practicum, where each credit is equivalent to 50 clock hours, totaling 400 hours of practicum for the Generalist Curriculum. Students have the option of completing hours in one semester or concurrently over two semesters. The Field Director will place students in area agencies.

Prerequisite(s): SOCWK 5000 History and Philosophy of Social Work in the United States and permission of Field Director.
