As such, students will explore theories and empirical studies related to offending, victimization, and employment. This course is cross listed with **GEND 3380** and meets with **SOC 2380/GEND 2380**. The requirements of the 3380 course will be the same as the 2380 course EXCEPT that students in the higher course number conduct an additional major project as determined by the instructor.
