NURS 4300 Medical/Surgical Nursing IV Critical Care and Leadership

This course is designed to provide nursing students with the skills and knowledge to care competently and safely for critically ill patients as well as provide leadership on basic nursing units. The course focuses on the application of quality nursing care according to priorities. Advanced information about the nursing process of patients in the critical care setting is used as an approach to providing holistic patient care. The course will emphasize nursing leadership concepts and theories used in variety of clinical settings. A clinical course (NURS 4300C Medical/Surgical Nursing IV Critical Care and Leadership Clinical) is also required.

Prerequisites: NURS 2350 Medical Surgical II and NURS 2110 Pharmacology II with grades of "C+" or better.

Corequisite(s): NURS 4300C Medical/Surgical Nursing IV Critical Care and Leadership Clinical.
