<b>German</b> 8 hours of MGRMN at the 3000 or 4000 level.	<b>8 hours</b>
<b>Japanese</b> 10 hours of MJPAN at the 2000 or 3000 level.	<b>10 hours</b>
<b>Spanish</b> 8 hours of MSPAN at the 3000 or 4000 level.	<b>8 hours</b>
<b>Other Language</b> Select courses in another language, as approved by Department Chair.	<b>8-10 hours</b>
<b>2. Modern Language Studies Electives</b>	<b>6 hours</b>

- Credits may be earned in any language course that is not counted toward the 8-10 hours of 3000/4000 credit for the Language of Concentration.
