In this advanced practice course, students will learn to assess the type of traumatic event and intensity of exposure. Students will explore tools and measures used when completing a clinical assessment, with specific attention to the clinical assessment of individuals and families who have experienced trauma. Students will explore the theoretical foundations for these assessment strategies. Students will explore how assessment can be used to draw conclusions and inform recommendations for future action, including the use of interdisciplinary perspectives.
